


Pdf+: Quick start

Pdf+ allows you to view Adobe Acrobat or Portable Document Format (PDF) document files on your Series 60 Smartphone.


Pdf+ as a stand-alone application.


Start Pdf+ by choosing its icon  from the main Menu.

The File view

Once Pdf+ is running, it displays a list of PDF documents  and folders in its File view.

You should scroll up and down to select a document.

You should scroll to the left and to the right to go to a different drive, if your Smartphone has a memory card .

Press the the scroll key to open a document, or to open a folder. The navigation bar  shows how where you are in the folder structure, and the title bar shows the name of the folder. When you have opened a folder, press the **Back** button to go up one level in the folder structure .

Press the **Exit** button to stop running Pdf+, or press the **Options** button and select

- **Open** to start reading a document.
- **Send** to send a file to another user.
- **Delete** to delete a document or a folder.
- **Move to folder** to move a file to another folder.
- **New folder** to create a new folder.
- **Rename** to rename a file or folder.
- **About Pdf+** to display information about the program.
- **Exit** to stop running Pdf+.

When opening a password-protected document, Pdf+ asks for a password. If you don't know the password, you cannot open the document.

The Page view

Once you opened a document, Pdf+ starts with displaying the first page in the Page view. You will see the title change to the name of the file. The navigation bar tells you which page Pdf+ is displaying, how many pages there are in the document, and whether it is still busy rendering the page. You'll see only a small part of the screen. Use the scroll keys to move around the page.

Tip: Even while Pdf+ is rendering a page, you can move around the page, or select a command from the menu. Only when Pdf+ is rendering a big image it doesn't respond to your commands.

When displaying a document, Pdf+ can be in two basic modes, *Unwrapped* and *Wrapped*. In *Unwrapped* mode, Pdf+ displays a page as it would look when it was printed or displayed on a PC. In *Wrapped* mode, Pdf+ reflows the text on the page to make it fit the small screen of your Smartphone. You'll notice that in *Wrapped* mode no images or line drawings are displayed. There are also some functions that do not work in *Wrapped* mode.

To select *Wrapped* mode, press the **Options** button and select **Wrap to screen**. To select *Unwrapped* mode, press the **Options** button and select **Don't wrap**.



To stop reading a document, press the **Back** button.

To select a command, press the **Options** button. Pdf+ only lists a command when you can actually execute it. For instance, on the first page of a document, you can only go to the next page, and not to a previous page. And another example: if the page does not contain links, the **Next link** command is not listed.

Press the Options button and select

- **Next page** to go to the next page.
- **Prev. page** to go to the previous page
- **Go to page** to go to an existing page. Pdf+ asks for a page number.
- **Find** to search for a string. Pdf+ asks for a string to search for.
- **Find next** to search for the next occurrence of a string.
- **Next link** to go to the next link on a page.
- **Zoom** leads to a sub menu where you can zoom in, zoom out or select a zoomlevel.
- **Wrap to screen** to select Wrapped mode
- **Don't wrap** to select Normal mode.
- **Full screen** to use the entire screen for displaying a page
- **Normal screen** to display the title and status pane.
- **Rotate** leads to a sub menu where you can choose to rotate the page by 0, 90, 180 or 270 degrees.
- **Bookmarks** to display the bookmarks view.
- **Save** to save a copy of the document.
- **Settings** to set the settings view.
- **Document info** to display information about the document that the creator of the document added to it, such as the title and the creation date.
- **About Pdf+** to display information about Pdf+ itself.
- **Exit** to stop using Pdf+.

The Bookmarks view

The Bookmarks view displays a list of bookmarks. Press **Back** to return to the Page view. Scroll up and down to move up and down the list of bookmarks. Press on the scroll key to open a nested bookmark  or to follow a normal bookmark . Press the **Follow** button to follow a bookmark. Scroll to the left and right to open and close a nested bookmark. The navigation bar shows you whether you can scroll to the left or right.

The Settings view

The Settings view allows you to set the parameters which Pdf+ use to render a page. These settings are used when you open a document.

Pdf+ as a viewer.

When you have received a PDF document as an attachment to an email or beamed via infra red, your Smartphone calls upon Pdf+ to display the document when you open it from the Messaging application. If the document is password-protected, you must enter the password to open it. Pdf+ will display the document in its Page view. You can use all Page view commands when Pdf+ is a viewer. Especially important is the Save command, as this command allows you to save the document

in a folder of your choosing.
