## What is Pdf+?

Pdf+ (for UIQ 3.x smartphones) allows you to view Portable Document Format (PDF) document files, also known as Adobe® Acrobat® files, on your UIQ 3.x smartphone. Optimized for mobile phones, Pdf+ is very easy to use, fast, small and packs a lot of features.

## Compatibility



The UIQ 3.x distribution of Pdf+ is for UIQ 3.x smartphones, such as the SonyEricsson P1, the SonyEricsson W950 and the Motorola Z8. This manual describes two distributions, the regular one for UIQ 3.x smartphones without Pdf+ in ROM, and the ROM upgrade distribution for UIQ 3.x smartphones with Pdf+ included in ROM. The ROM upgrade distribution can only be installed on UIQ 3.x devices with Pdf+ in ROM, it will not function on other UIQ 3.x devices.

## Editions

Pdf+ for UIQ 3.x smartphones comes in two editions, Pdf+ Basic and Pdf+ Standard. It is also possible to upgrade Pdf+ Basic to Pdf+ Standard by purchasing and installing Pdf+ Standard Upgrade. This manual describes both editions.

The ROM Upgrade distribution is identical to the Pdf+ Standard edition.

## Installing Pdf+

Both the regular and the upgrade distributions of Pdf+ are installed as a sis file. Check the user manual of your smartphone if you are not sure how to install a sis file on your smartphone.

When you install the Pdf+ Standard upgrade, you need to close Pdf+ Basic first. Otherwise the addition of the Standard features will not be picked up correctly. You can close Pdf+ using the Task Manager, or by powering down the phone itself.

After upgrading with the ROM upgrade distribution, you will see two instances of Pdf+ on your device. The ROM

version is called Pdf+, the ROM Upgrade version is called Pdf+ Standard.

## Using Pdf+

Start Pdf+ by selecting its icon  in the Application launcher, and executing the **Open** command

You can set the application folder for Pdf+ by selection it and executing the **Move to folder** command.

## The File view



Pdf+ displays a list of PDF documents and folders in the File view. The available drives are represented by tabs in the context pane, just below the menu bar.

Open a PDF document or a folder by tapping on it, or by executing the **Open** command. Pdf+ will open the document in the Page view.

When opening a password-protected document, Pdf+ asks for a password. If you don't know the password, you cannot open the document.

When opening a folder, Pdf+ shows the contents of the folder. Execute the **Up** command or use the **Up** folder to move back to the parent folder.

A tick in the check box means that the file or folder is marked, i.e. part of the current selection. Some commands will operate on the entire selection, and not just a single file or folder.

Execute the **Mark** command on a file or folder or tap on the check box to mark it, tap again or execute the **Unmark** command to remove it from the selection.

The following commands are available:

- **New folder** – create a new folder.
- **Edit > Rename** - rename a single file or folder.
- **Edit > Copy** and **Edit > Move** - copy or move the current selection to a new position in the file structure. **Copy** creates duplicates, **Move** removes the source files and folders.
- **Delete** - delete the files and folders in the current selection. The removal is permanent, you must confirm that you want to delete the current selection.
- **Send as** - send the current file by Bluetooth, Infra-red and E-mail to another device.
- **Help** - display this help text.
- **About Pdf+** - display information about Pdf+.

When opening a password-protected document, Pdf+ asks for a password. If you don't know the password, you cannot open the document.

## The Page view

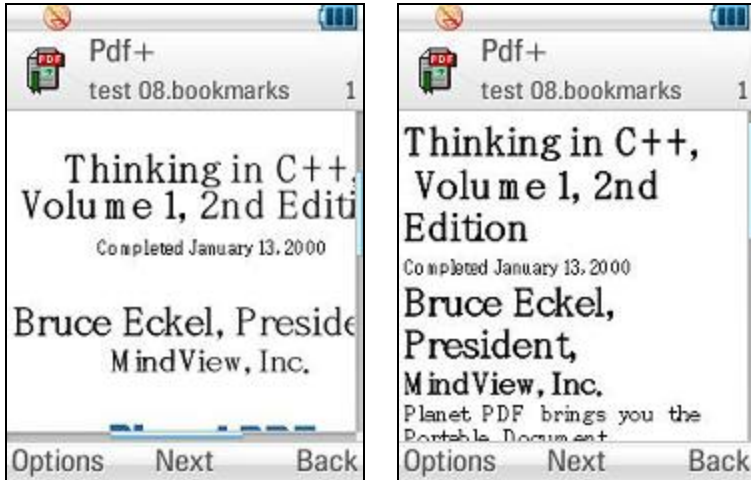
After opening a document, Pdf+ displays the first page in the Page view.

Pdf+ displays a “Drawing...” message at the top left of the screen while it is rendering the page. You'll see only

a small part of the screen. Use the scroll bars to move around the page.

Even while Pdf+ is rendering a page, you can move around the page, or select a command from the menu. Only when Pdf+ is rendering a big image it doesn't respond to your commands.












In the view context pane you will see the document's file name and the current page number to the right.



When displaying a document, Pdf+ can be in two basic modes, *Unwrapped* and *Wrapped*. In *Unwrapped* mode, Pdf+ displays a page as if it was printed or displayed on a PC. In *Wrapped* mode, Pdf+ reflows the page to make it fit the width of the screen. In *Wrapped* mode no images or line drawings are displayed, and some commands are not available.

Pdf+ dims a command when you cannot execute it. For instance, on the first page of a document, you can not go to the previous page so the **Prev. page** command is not available. Another example: if the page does not contain links, the **Next link** command is not available.

The following commands are available:

- **Follow**  - to follow the current link (Pdf+ Standard).
- **Website**  - to visit the website (Pdf+ Standard).
- **E-mail**  - to send an e-mail (Pdf+ Standard).
- **Call**  - to call the phone number (Pdf+ Standard).
- **0 Next**  - display the next part of the screen. At the bottom of the page the commands displays the next page. In Column mode, the command first goes to the top of the next column on a page. A column is defined as the with of the screen.
- **5 Next Link**  - go to the next link, if there is a link on the page. Tap on the link itself to follow it (Pdf+ Standard).
- **7 Find**  - display the find dialog. You can enter a search string here and let Pdf+ find it for you.
- **9 Find next** - search for the next occurrence of the search string.
- **Go to > 1 Prev. page**, **Go to > 3 Next page** - go to the previous and next page.
- **Go to > 2 Go to page** - show the Go to page dialog. You can enter the page you want to go to.
- **Display > \* Full screen**  - use the entire screen for displaying a page. Press the menu icon in the top left part of the screen to show a command menu.
- **Display > # Wrap to screen**  - select *Wrapped* mode.
- **Display > Column mode** - toggle between Column mode and normal mode. In Column mode the Next move command moves to the top of the next column on a page, instead of displaying the next page.
- **Display > Zoom**  - set the zoom level.
- **Display > Rotate** - set the rotation factor of the page (0, 90, 180 or 270 degrees).
- **Display > Landscape** - toggle between Portrait and Landscape mode.
- **8 Bookmarks**  - show the Bookmarks view, if the document contains bookmarks (Pdf+ Standard).
- **Document > Rename** - rename this document.
- **Document > Send as** - send this document to another device.
- **Document > Delete** - delete this document. Deleting a document cannot be undone.
- **Document info** - display the information that the creator of the document added to it, such as the title

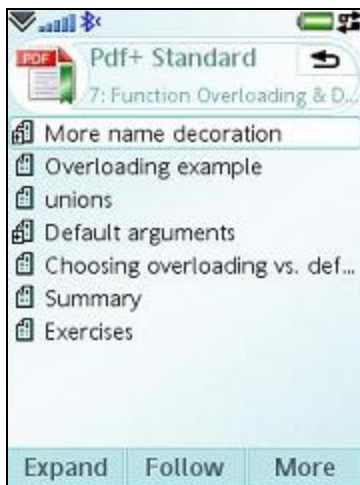
and the creation date.

- **Preferences > Preferences** - set your preferences for displaying a document.
- **Preferences > Font preferences** - set the font preferences, the mapping between Standard PDF fonts and the fonts available on your device.
- **Help** - display the help text.
- **About Pdf+** - display information about Pdf+ itself.
- The Return button returns you to the File view.

Pressing **4** will zoom in, pressing **6** will zoom out.

## The Bookmark view




The Bookmark view displays a list of bookmarks (Pdf+ Standard).



A bookmark can be either a leaf, a collapsed bookmark or an expanded bookmark. Tapping on a leaf or an expanded bookmark will make Pdf+ follow the bookmark. Tapping on a collapsed bookmark will expand the bookmark.

You can also use the jog dial to move to a bookmark. Press the jog dial to follow a bookmark.

The following commands are available:

- **Follow**  - follow a bookmark.
- **Expand**  - expand a collapsed bookmark.
- **Collapse**  - collapse an expanded bookmark.
- The Return button returns you to the Page view.
- **Document info** - display the information that the creator of this document added to it, such as the title and the creation date.
- **Help** - display this help text.
- **About Pdf+** - display information about Pdf+ itself.
